

RAISED GARDEN CENTER- #1424- #1436- #1448

Quality Western Red Cedar with Handcrafted Construction

Assembly Instructions: All holes are pre-drilled and screws are included. Check all packing material carefully before discarding as shortages of parts may occur from parts left in packaging. Read instructions carefully before beginning to assemble your GROUND PLANTER.

Tools Required for Assembly: #2 Phillips screwdriver or an electric screwdriver with a #2 Phillips head bit

PARTS LIST:

2 End Wall Sections

2 Side Wall Sections

16- 3" Screws

ASSEMBLY:

NOTE: This assembly is best executed with two people.

STEP 1: Start by identifying the End Wall Sections. The End Wall Sections have the 2x 4's protruding out from the ends 1 ½" and are pre-drilled. (See Figure 3)
Note: The 2x 4 rails with the 45 degree angle cuts are the TOP of the sections

STEP 2: Lay-out the Wall Sections with the End Walls across from each other and the Side Walls across from each other.
Note: The vertical 2x 4's on the Wall Sections are the OUTSIDE of the section (See Figure 2)

STEP 3: Raise one End Wall Section up and one Side Wall Section up and using 2- 3" screws attach the wall sections together through the pre-drilled holes in the vertical 2x 4's. Repeat the process on all four corners until a box is formed.
Note: When the box is formed the Side Wall Sections should be to the INSIDE of the End Wall Sections. (See Figure 1)

STEP 4: After the box is together and sitting on a flat surface, begin installing the 2- 3" screws in each 45 degree corner. (See Figure 1)
Note: Please use care when installing these screws. You may have to adjust the tension on each screw to form a tighter 45 degree angle. There will be a total of 8- 3" screws for the 4- 45 degree corners.

Note: Western Red Cedar contains natural preservatives, so it resists rot, and weathers well. These qualities make cedar ideal for outdoor use. A quality sealer or stain on all areas will delay the graying of the wood and give additional protection. Cedar will weather to a silvery gray if left in its natural state. We would recommend a location for your garden planter that will receive full sun light. Ordinary soil is too heavy for container gardening and we would recommend a light pre-mixed soil.
