

PARK BENCH- #2548

Quality Western Red Cedar with Handcrafted Construction

Assembly Instructions: All holes are pre-drilled and screws are included. Check all packing material carefully before discarding as shortages of parts may occur from parts left in packaging. Read instructions carefully before beginning to assemble your PARK BENCH.

Tools Required for Assembly: #2 Phillips screwdriver or an electric screwdriver with a #2 Phillips head bit

PARTS LIST:

1 Back Section

1 Bench Section

2 Side Arm Sections 1-Right 1- Left

1 Package of Screws- 16- 3" Screws

ASSEMBLY:

NOTE: This assembly is best executed with two people.

STEP 1: Start your assembly by laying out the four sections with the Back & Bench Sections in the middle and the Side Arm Sections on each side. The left section as you look from the front will have the arm rest overhang on the left and on the right for the right section.

STEP 2: Take both the Side Arm Sections and lay them on there back so the taper will be facing up. (See Figures 5 & 6) Take the Bench Section and place it in between the Side Arm Sections positioning the BOTTOM of the Bench Section on the 12" mark on the Side Arm Sections. Attach the two Side Arm Sections to the Bench Section using the 6- 3" screws and the pre-drilled holes on each side.

Note: DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN THE SCREWS UNTIL LATER

STEP 3: Once the bench Section is secure stand the bench upright on a flat surface. Take the Back Section and place it so the TOP of the Back Section matches the TOP of the Side Arm Sections. Using the 4- 3" screws and the pre-drilled holes, attach the Back Section but **DO NOT TIGHTEN** the screws.

Note: The Back Section fits to the INSIDE of the two Side Arm Sections.

STEP 4: Once the Bench Section and the Back Section are in place, go back and tighten **ALL** the screws taking care not to over tighten them.

Note: Western Red Cedar contains natural preservatives, so it resists rot, and weathers well. These qualities make cedar ideal for outdoor use. A quality sealer or stain on all areas will delay the graying of the wood and give additional protection. Cedar will weather to a silvery gray if left in its natural state. We would recommend a location for your garden planter that will receive full sun light. Ordinary soil is too heavy for container gardening and we would recommend a light pre-mixed soil.
